



Selectmen's Policy
Alfred Transfer Station Sticker Guidelines

1. Only vehicles registered in Alfred can receive a window sticker. This is done when you register your vehicle at the Tax Collectors Office. These stickers are color coordinated with the tags on your license plate. If you register online you can bring in your registration and we will give you a sticker. A new sticker is issued each time you register your vehicle.
2. If your vehicle is NOT registered in Alfred and registered in a different town or state or if using a friend's vehicle you may obtain a "Temporary" white permit. You must bring in the vehicles registration. This permit can be made valid for a day, week or longer as needed as approved.
3. If you own only land you may obtain a "Temporary" white permit with proof of ownership for the purpose of cleanup of trash/debris from that property. This permit can be made valid for a day, week or longer as needed as approved.
4. If you own property and only reside part time in Alfred you may obtain a "Summer Resident" yellow permit. You must bring in the vehicles registration if obtaining your first permit. This permit is valid through December 31st and needs to be reissued each year. Limit 3 permits per household.
5. If you rent a house or apartment you may obtain a "Temporary" permit by providing proof of residency with a lease agreement, utility bill or piece of mail showing the physical address. You can change your vehicle registration to the Alfred address in the Tax Collectors Office at no charge and then be given a window sticker. This also applies to anyone who recently purchased a property. You will need to provide proof of purchase to obtain a permit.
6. If you are a Contractor/Builder doing business in Alfred you must obtain a "Commercial" permit to dispose of any demolition from the Alfred residents home in which you are doing business. This is done with an application process through the Selectmen's Office. If approved this permit is good through December 31st and is renewed annually. For further information see the Town's Solid Waste Ordinance.
7. If you are a "Contracted Hauler" and have customers in which you pick up household waste (MSW) and recyclables, you may obtain a permit to dispose of MSW and recyclables with an application process through the Selectmen's Office. There is a non-refundable \$100 application fee and an annual \$100 fee for this permit. You will also be required to show proof of liability insurance of not less than \$500,000. You will also be required to show a 911 address list of all customers you provide service to. For further information see Town's Solid Waste Ordinance.
8. Alfred Businesses are requested and expected to provide their own dumpsters, but if needed, "Special Business Permits" are available through the Selectmen's office upon approval.

You may obtain these permits during regular business hours at the Town Hall.
